Application for Group B must be recommended by **ATOD teacher members**, and copies of ATOD Examination certificates are required for applications.

1. ATOD Examination Solo Dance Combination

Children (6-9 years), Teens (10-15 years), Open Group (16 years & above)
Content based on ATOD syllabus on Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary, Hip Hop and Character Dance.
All costumes are of own choice.

2. ATOD student choreography

Choreographer must be of age 16-25. Choreography could either be Solo/ Duet/ Trio / Group (not more than 8) of Ballet/ Jazz/ Hip Hop/ Contemporary / Character Dance. Costumes are of own choice and design.

For the sake of fairness, teacher's advice or involvement is not encouraged.

Regulations:

- 1.Age of applicants based on Day of Birth
- 2.Order of Competition is by ballot and would be notified in August.
- 3.Prize: GOLD, SILVER, AND BRONZE for all groups. All participants are eligible of participation certificates. On top of GOLD, SILVER or BRONZE awards for all groups, Best Performer and Best Choreographer will also be awarded. Participants of Students Choreography Competition are eligible of certificates of participation.
- 4. Duration: Not more than 2 minutes for Solo/ Duet/ Trio dances

Not more than 4 minutes for Group dances.

5. Finalist Performance will be held at the Christian Community Centre (Kwun Tong) on **2 Oct, 2014**, details will be delivered to all applicants in a later time.
